Our Nutra Pampered Pets Shampoo does not foam because we do not use sulfates in our ingredients. Sulfates are great at stripping oils from hair but in the process damage and rob your hair of nutrients.

Here is a short list of ingredients that should not be in your shampoo for your family.

Alcohol

Most alcohols have a drying effect, and the higher up in the ingredient list it appears, the more of it the product contains. Some alcohols that are not as bad for dry hair start with a "C" or an "S", like Cetearyl alcohol and Stearyl alcohol. They can actually help your hair retain moisture.

Ammonium Lauryl Sulfate

Sulfates are a type of surfactants (a compound that lower the surface tension), and are very common shampoo ingredients. These cleaning agents are so harsh they can damage the hair, make it brittle, and increase frizz. They can also cause allergic reactions in people with sensitive skin.

Sodium Chloride

Sodium chloride is simply salt. Salt can make an already sensitive scalp dry and itchy, which can eventually be a cause of hair loss. It can also irritate and burn your eyes if you get shampoo in them.

Polyethylene Glycols (PEG)

This is also a thickening agent that can be directly harmful to humans since they are derived from petroleum.

Formaldehyde

Formaldehyde is a known human carcinogen and has been proven to be absorbed through the skin in animal testing. One that is common in shampoos is quaternium-15. In 2013, hundreds of American women sued Unilever after experiencing hair loss, burnt scalps, and broken or discolored hair after using an at-home hair-smoothing product.

Synthetic Colors

Colors come from petroleum or coal-tar sources, all of which come with harmful health effects.

Dimethicone

A type of silicone, dimethicone is a plastic that is used in a ton of hair products and contributes to product buildup that makes your hair feel greasy. It can clog the pores on the scalp and cause skin irritation. Many face creams also contain some type of silicone, as it is what makes the cream glide nicely onto our skin, and many people have reported increased acne or skin problems.

Cocamidopropyl Betaine

Most shampoos, even the ones claiming to be natural, contain cocamidopropyl betaine, which is another foam booster. Do not let the fact that it is a natural compound from coconuts trick you!

Hair products use it together with something called dimethylaminopropylamine which can cause skin irritation, allergy, rosacea, and eczema.
